

AIIC WELCOMES VICTORIAN GOVERNMENT ACTION ON CEILING INSULATION FOR RENTAL PROPERTIES

The Affiliated Insulation Industry Coalition (AIIC) congratulates the Victorian Government on its decision to proceed with the introduction of a minimum rental standard for ceiling insulation in homes where none currently exists.

“This is a welcome and important step toward improving the health, comfort and energy affordability of rental households across the state,” said Janine Strachan, Chair of the AIIC. “Properly installed insulation is one of the most effective ways to reduce energy bills and create healthier homes.”

The AIIC looks forward to working closely with the government to ensure quality and safety are central to implementation, as has been successfully demonstrated through similar work in the ACT.

The AIIC also encourages the Victorian Government to consider future expansion of the standard to include under-insulated properties, which remain widespread and in need of urgent upgrades to meet modern expectations of thermal performance.
